The Office of the CISO (Chief Information Security Officer) is dedicated to managing the state's cybersecurity posture. It deals with a broad range of security concerns, from strategic planning, compliance, and incident response to cybersecurity awareness training and the operational planning of security measures. This office is key in orchestrating responses to security incidents and implementing strategic cybersecurity initiatives, and leads an Emergency Support Function, ESF CYBER, under the state comprehensive emergency management plan.
